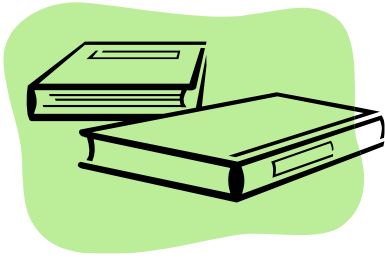

What is a Kobe night junior high school like?

1. When would I attend night school?

The night school program runs on Mondays to Fridays from 5:30 pm to 9 pm. Every day, there are four 40-minute classes.

2. What would I study?

Students will study the nine subjects covered in junior high school. Students can also start with studying hiragana characters and basic math.

(*Students can receive junior high school graduation qualifications through this program.)

3. Who will be my classmates?

Night school students can include people who were unable to graduate elementary and/or junior high school due to various circumstances, or who were unable to attend school regularly due to frequent absences or other reasons. (They can be from a wide range of ages and nationalities.)
